SOME QUESTIONS FOR PERSONAL REFLECTION & DISCUSSION:

—Please carefully observe/read Genesis 3:1–13 & Matthew 4:1–11.
What do these passages teach us about the problem of temptation?
How did Eve react/respond to the serpent’s questions? (Did she seem fearful, confused, or prepared to face this challenge?)
How did Jesus react/respond to the devil’s requests?
Why is it beneficial to use biblical truth in dealing with temptation?

—How often do you personally face temptation?

—How often do you recognize that you are being tempted?

—The adversary/devil can’t or isn’t always the blame or cause of our temptations. At times he might recognize our weaknesses and bring a challenge to us, but we are also influenced and impacted by our sinful nature. What is the most common cause of temptation for you?

—How do you deal with the challenges created by temptation?

—Please consider these questions in a personal manner:

1—Do I recognize the **IMPACT & INFLUENCE SIN** has on my life?

2—Have I **ENTRUSTED** my life to Christ by **TRUSTING** in His **SACRIFICE?**
How does this provide help for me in a personal way?
